

DSWD DROMIC Report #18 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 21 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **34,896 families** or **159,157 persons** are affected in **103 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
 - A total of **808 families** or **3,493 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **13** evacuation centers in Regions XI and XII (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **75 families** or **375 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **883 families** or **3,868 persons** still displaced in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **1,219 houses** were damaged; of which, **444** are **totally damaged** and **775** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱29,056,770.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱27,310,095.00 from DSWD and ₱1,746,675.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱3.30 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱38 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 249,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 113,477 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 136,500 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 227,175 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1,701,785 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱928. 41 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, DSWD FO XI and FO XII warehouses.
