

DSWD DROMIC Report #19 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) as of 25 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

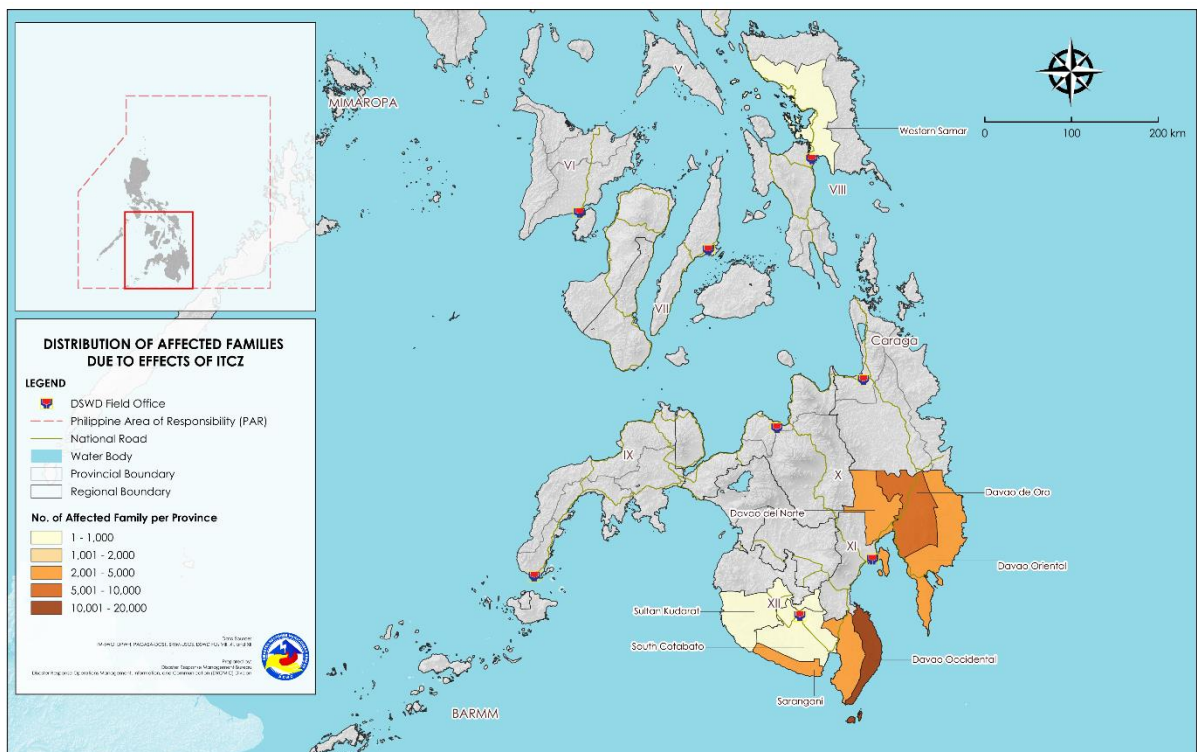
On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

On 29 December 2024, a landslide occurred at Sitio Mahaba, Brgy. Basiao, Catbalogan City, Samar due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **34,898 families** or **159,165 persons** are affected in **104 barangays** in **Regions VIII, XI, and XII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **808 families** or **3,493 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **13 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **77 families** or **383 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **885 families** or **3,876 persons** still displaced in **Regions VIII, XI, and XII** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **1,221 houses** were damaged; of which, **445** are **totally damaged** and **776** are **partially damaged** in **Regions VIII, XI, and XII** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱29,084,933.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱27,325,258.00** from **DSWD** and **₱1,759,675.00** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)** (see Annex H).
