

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City

as of 27 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 January 2025 at around 2:07 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 5, Isla Puting Bato, Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:14 AM.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, has actively engaged in the response operation and maintained continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of Manila City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **80 families** or **282 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **80 families** or **282 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok 5 Chapel** in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 35 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex C).
