

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City as of 21 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 January 2025 at around 5:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sulucan St., Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:58 AM.

A total of **320 families** or **1,074 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **320 families** or **1,074 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. 458 Open Court** in **Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **100 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex C).
