

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City as of 27 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2025 at around 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VII, has actively engaged in the response operation and maintained continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of Lapu-Lapu City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **58 families** or **286 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **36 families** or **164 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **122 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **58 families** or **286 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **46 houses** were damaged; of which, **42** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex G).
