

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City

as of 29 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2025 at around 7:04 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 7:55 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Iloilo City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 30 families or 102 persons are affected in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 18 families or 89 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Hall in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **13 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **30 families** or **102 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 30 houses were damaged; of which, 25 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}259,288.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}75,060.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}184,228.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
