

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zaniga, Mandaluyong City as of 21 January 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 January 2025 at around 2:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Zaniga, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 3:31 PM.

A total of **60 families** or **237 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Zaniga, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **60 families** or **237 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Addition Hills** in **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Zaniga, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).
