

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incidents in SOCCSKSARGEN

as of 10 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2025 at around 6:19 PM, heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms caused a flash flood in seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. By 08 January 2025 at around 3 AM, the same weather conditions triggered another flash flood in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

On 09 January 2025 at around 5:57 PM in Brgy. Pamantingan, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat, also experienced a flash flood incident due to same weather disturbance.

A total of 1,154 families or 6,604 persons are affected in 10 barangays in Region XII (see Annex A).
