

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incidents in Davao Region as of 07 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2025 at around 6:00 PM, a flooding incident caused by heavy rainfall brought about by localized thunderstorms was experienced in a river in Brgy. 74-A Matina Crossing, Davao City.

The flooding incident resulted in impassable roads and heightened risk to residents in low-lying and flood-prone areas in Barangays Matina Aplaya, Matina Crossing, Matina Pangi, Davao City and Brgy. Ising, Carmen in Davao del Norte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **627 families** or **2,261 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Affected Areas and Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **10 families** or **50 persons** took temporary shelter at the **Municipal Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Ising, Carmen, Davao del Norte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Davao City** (see Annex B).
