





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Region X

as of 15 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 08 January 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought possible flashfloods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the country.

On the same day, heavy rains were experienced in several municipalities in Bukidnon and Lanao del Norte, resulting to damages to multiple properties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,018 families** or **8,875 persons** are affected in **15 barangays** in **Region X** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 17 families or 85 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Region X (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **887 houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **885** are **partially damaged** in **Region X** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}1,778,451.60\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}866,846.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}911,605.60\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
