

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Mandaue City, Cebu as of 29 January 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Looc and Brgy. Opao in Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 7:33 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **126 families** or **477 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **126 families** or **477 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **101 houses** were damaged; of which, **100** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱149,280.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
