

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Tribal Conflict in Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon as of 10 January 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2024 at around 6:00 PM, a tribal conflict transpired between two (2) members of the Matigsalog tribe in Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon which resulted to the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **347 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **81 families** or **347 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Court** in **Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱448,416.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱335,016.00** from **DSWD** and **₱113,400.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
