

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Tribal Conflict in Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon

as of 10 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2024 at around 6:00 PM, a tribal conflict transpired between two (2) members of the Matigsalog tribe in Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon which resulted to the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **347 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **81 families** or **347 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Court** in **Brgy. Cayaga, San Fernando, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱448,416.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱335,016.00 from DSWD and ₱113,400.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
