

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flash Flood Incidents in SOCCSKSARGEN

as of 14 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On January 7, 2025, at approximately 6:19 PM, heavy rains caused by localized thunderstorms resulted in a flash flood affecting seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. On January 8, 2025, at around 3:00 AM, the same weather conditions triggered another flash flood in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

Subsequently, on January 9, 2025, at approximately 5:57 PM, a flash flood occurred in Barangay Pamantingan, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat, due to the continuing weather disturbance.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,549 families** or **11,570 persons** are affected in **20 barangays** in **Region XII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 21 families or 72 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Region XII (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 22 families or 74 persons still displaced in Region XII (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Region XII (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,096,810.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
