

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flash Flood Incidents in SOCCSKSARGEN as of 14 January 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On January 7, 2025, at approximately 6:19 PM, heavy rains caused by localized thunderstorms resulted in a flash flood affecting seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. On January 8, 2025, at around 3:00 AM, the same weather conditions triggered another flash flood in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

Subsequently, on January 9, 2025, at approximately 5:57 PM, a flash flood occurred in Barangay Pamantingan, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat, due to the continuing weather disturbance.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,549 families** or **11,570 persons** are affected in **20 barangays** in **Region XII** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **72 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **two (2) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **22 families** or **74 persons** still displaced in **Region XII** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Region XII** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,096,810.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
