

# DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Northern Mindanao

as of 22 January 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 08 January 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought possible flashfloods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the country.

On the same day, heavy rains were experienced in several municipalities in Bukidnon and Lanao del Norte, resulting to damages to multiple properties.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,023 families** or **8,895 persons** are affected in **15 barangays** in **Region X** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **49 families** or **185 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Magsaysay Evacuation Center** in **Kibawe, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **889 houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **888** are **partially damaged** in **Region X** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,474,357.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,556,317.00** from **DSWD** and **₱918,040.60** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
