

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental

21 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 06 September 2024 at 4:00 AM: The weather forecast indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies, with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms that could have triggered the risk of flash floods or landslides, particularly during periods of severe thunderstorms in certain areas of the country.

On the same day, heavy rainfall was recorded in Barangay North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental, resulting in an uprooted tree incident that caused damage to multiple properties.

A total of **two (2) families** or **eight (8) persons** sought temporary shelter at **North Poblacion Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,792.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
