

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Masipag, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

22 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 January 2025 at around 6:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Masipag, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **24 families** or **76 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Masipag**, **Puerto Princesa City**, **Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of six (6) families or 15 persons took temporary shelter in Brgy. Masipag Hall, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **18 families** or **61 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends in **Brgy. Masipag, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **24 families** or **76 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Masipag, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and seven (7) are partially damaged in Brgy. Masipag, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}406,303.40\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}20,303.40\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}362,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}24,000.00\$ from other non-government organizations (see Annex F).
