

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pong-ol, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur 29 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 November 2024 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Pong-ol, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur.

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pong-ol, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱20,074.26** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱18,724.26** from **DSWD** and **₱1,350.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
