

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Buhisan, San Agustin, Surigao del Sur

15 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 January 2025 at around 8:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army (NPA) at Sitio Kabuluhan, Sitio Yadawan, and Sitio Magkahonaw in Brgy. Buhisan, San Agustin, Surigao del Sur.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the Caraga Region, swiftly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **179 families** or **728 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Buhisan, San Agustin, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).
