

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Diatagon, Lianga, Surigao del Sur

15 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 January 2025 at around 5:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Diatagon, Lianga, Surigao del Sur between members of New People's Army and Third Special Forces Battalion of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP). The incident resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the said barangay.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the Caraga Region, swiftly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **269 families** or **1,204 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Diatagon**, **Lianga**, **Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱327,335.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱192,335.00 from DSWD and ₱135,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex B).
