

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bagumbayan, City of Tabuk, Kalinga

03 March 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Pallikan, Brgy. Bagumbayan, City of Tabuk, Kalinga. The fire was declared out at around 2:30 PM.

A total of **four (4) families** or **18 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bagumbayan, City of Tabuk, Kalinga** (see Annex A).

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **four (4) families** or **18 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Bagumbayan, City of Tabuk, Kalinga** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱115,062.12** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱49,145.12** from **DSWD**, **₱13,799.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱11,000.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱41,118.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex D).
