

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City

26 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2024 at around 5:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Upper San Carlos Heights Road, Purok 5, Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 8:10 AM.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** were affected in **Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,252.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱10,252.40** from **DSWD** and **₱12,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
