

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Davao de Oro

27 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2023 at 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to the Low-Pressure Area at 530 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.6°N, 130.8°E) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate with at times heavy rain in Caraga and Davao Region.

On 14 March 2023 at around 3:00 AM, several municipalities in Davao de Oro experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by the LPA.

A total of **2,062 families** or **7,827 persons** were affected in **21 barangays** in **Davao De Oro** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **797 families** or **2,531 persons** took temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱645,151.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
