

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Santa Teresita, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro as of 14 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2025, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Tignuan, Brgy. Santa Teresita, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro between the combined forces of the 68th Infantry (Kaagapay) Battalion and the 4th Infantry (Scorpion) Battalion, under the 203rd Infantry (Bantay Kapayapaan) Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division (2ID) of the Philippine Army, and members of the New People's Army (NPA) of the Southern Tagalog Regional Party Committee (STRPC).

Due to the ongoing firefight, the Philippine Army imposed a five-day quarantine on the affected barangay to monitor residents' movement.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **112 families** or **528 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Santa Teresita, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱114,668.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱99,668.80** from **DSWD** and **₱15,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
