

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar

as of 25 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 February 2025 at around 5:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the Philippine Army and the New People's Army in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar. This conflict has led to the displacement of 231 individuals in the area.

In preparation for response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) VIII is in close coordination with the concerned Local Government Unit (LGU) and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.

A total of **60 families** or **231 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar** (see Annex A).

- 397,023 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 165,583 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 231,440 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 137,039 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱270.50 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
