

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 21 February 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2025 at around 8:18 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37 families** or **78 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **37 families** or **78 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱490,454.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱331,724.00** from **DSWD** and **₱158,730.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).

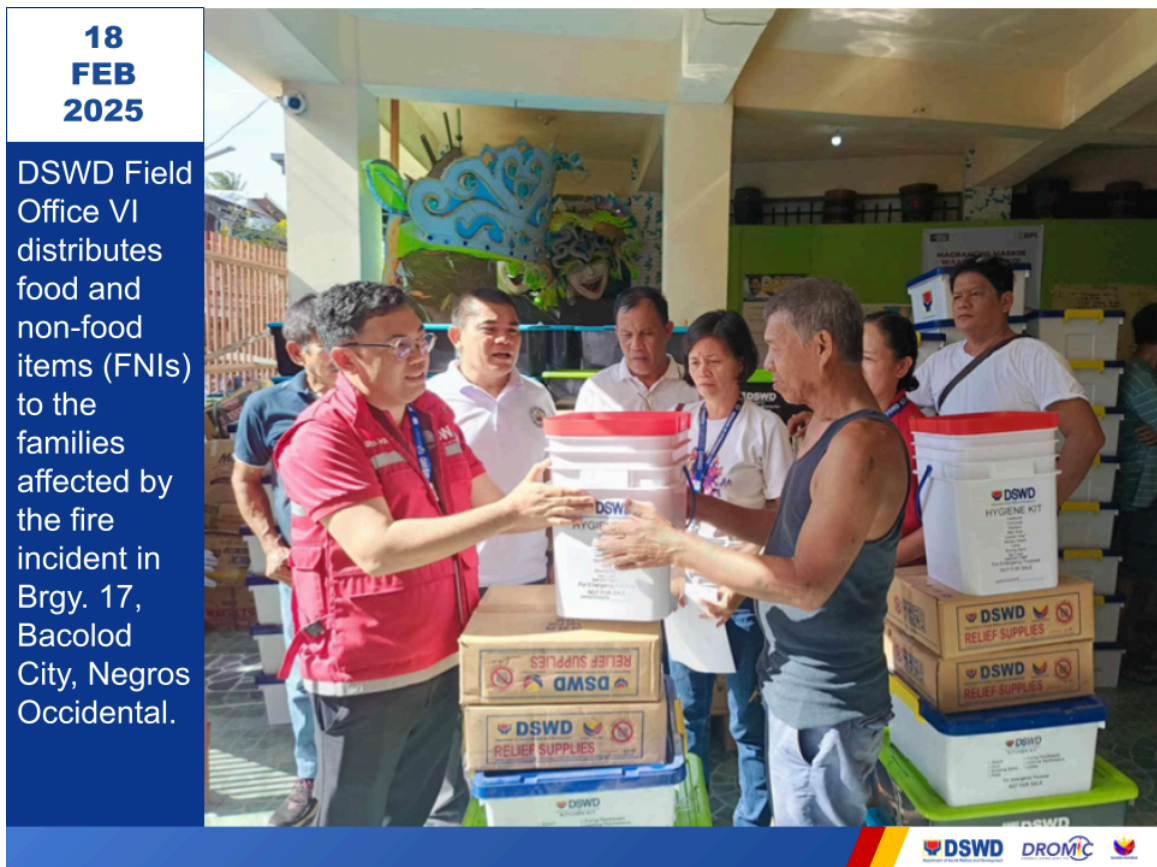
