

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 177, Malibay, Pasay City as of 20 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2025 at around 4:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at 12 Benita Esteban St., Brgy. 177- Zone 18, Malibay, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 7:25 AM.

A total of **78 families** or **233 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 177, Malibay, Pasay City** (see Annex A).

There are **78 families** or **233 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Hall Covered Court** in **Brgy. 177, Malibay, Pasay City** (see Annex B).

A total of **19 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 177, Malibay, Pasay City** (see Annex C).
