

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 353, Santa Cruz, Manila City

as of 18 February 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2025 at around 4:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kusangloob St. corner Ipil St., Brgy 353, Santa Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 8:18 PM.

A total of 61 families or 208 persons are affected in Brgy 353, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 61 families or 208 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Andres Bonifacio Elementary School in Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **23** are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy 353, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex C).
