

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte

as of 19 February 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2025 at around 7:38 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 39, Calvary Hill, Tacloban City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 9:04 AM.

A total of **161 families** or **476 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex A).

A total of **121 houses** were damaged; of which, **112** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex B).
