I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2025 at around 12:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Trinidad St., Brgy. 91, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:44 PM.

A total of **32 families** or **116 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 91, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Child Development Center** in **Brgy. 91, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱60,139.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
