

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City as of 17 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2025 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 7 Relocation Site, Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region VI, actively engaged in the response operation and has maintained continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Iloilo City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **29 families** or **95 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **29 families** or **95 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Buntatala Covered Court** in **Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).
