I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2025 at around 12:53 PM, a fire incident occurred at Adelfa St., Visayas Ave., Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 2:35 PM.

A total of **44 families** or **143 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **44 families** or **143 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Metro Heights Multipurpose Building** in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱190,692.48** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
