

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City

as of 13 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2025 at around 12:53 PM, a fire incident occurred at Adelfa St., Visayas Ave., Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 2:35 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 44 families or 143 persons are affected in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 44 families or 143 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Metro Heights Multipurpose Building in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 21 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P190,692.48** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
