

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Guba, Clarin, Misamis Occidental

as of 11 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 January 2025 at around 6:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Guba, Clarin, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 6:55 PM.

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Guba, Clarin, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Guba, Clarin, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,918.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱7,918.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
