

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Logero, Marabut, Samar as of 11 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 December 2024 at around 11:47PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Logero, Marabut, Samar.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Logero, Marabut, Samar** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **seven (7) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Logero, Marabut, Samar** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,910.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱20,910.00** from **DSWD** and **₱2,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
