# I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2025 at around 9:40 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Panay, Clarin, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of two (2) families or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Pan-ay, Clarin, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

# **III.** Status of Displaced Population

### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **three (3) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were partially damaged in Brgy. Pan-ay, Clarin, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱25,836.00worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱15,836.00 from DSWD and ₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
