

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte as of 19 February 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 February 2025 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 7:45 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **two (2) families** or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **two (2) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Quilao Chapel** in **Tolosa, Leyte** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **two (2) families** or **seven (7) persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
