

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte

as of 19 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 February 2025 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 7:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of two (2) families or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Quilao Chapel in Tolosa, Leyte (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are two (2) families or seven (7) persons still displaced in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Quilao, Tolosa, Leyte (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).


