

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City

as of 26 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2025 at around 6:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 7:04 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of eight (8) families or 27 persons are affected in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are seven (7) families or 24 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Brgy. San Jose Chapel in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are eight (8) families or 27 persons still displaced in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of eight (8) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}123,400.20\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}60,660.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}62,740.20\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
