## I. Situation Overview

On 03 February 2025 at around 5:28 AM, a fire incident occurred at Block 7, Samagta Floodway, Brgy. San Juan, Taytay, Rizal and it was declared out at around 7:09 AM.

There are 58 families or 213 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Brgy. San Juan Covered Court in Taytay, Rizal (see Annex B).
