

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar

as of 06 March 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 05 February 2025 at around 5:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the Philippine Army and the New People's Army in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar. This conflict has led to the displacement of 231 individuals in the area.

In response to this incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) VIII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **60 families** or **231 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Paranas, Samar** (see Annex A).
