

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Chemical Spill in Brgy. Mabuhay, General Santos City

as of 03 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 February 2025 at around 3:54 PM, a chemical spill occurred in Brgy. Mabuhay, General Santos City, affecting several families and individuals in the community. Four (4) individuals were subsequently hospitalized at Jorge Royeca Hospital. Likewise, the cause of the leak is currently under investigation.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region XII, has actively engaged in the response operation and maintained continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of General Santos City, to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

A total of 134 families or 575 persons are affected in Brgy. Mabuhay, General Santos City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 134 families or 575 persons sought temporary shelter in Brgy. Mabuhay Gym in General Santos City (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱30,000.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).
