

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao de Oro

as of 27 February 2025, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

Issued on 25 February 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Nabunturan and New Bataan in Davao de Oro. Source: DOST-PAGASA Daily Weather Bulletin and DSWD Field Office (FO) XI

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,088 families** or **4,805 persons** are affected in **20 barangays** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **757 families** or **3,165 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **17 families** or **70 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **774 families** or **3,235 persons** still displaced in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Nabunturan, Davao de Oro (see Annex E).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱29,315.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
