

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 28, Caloocan City

as of 15 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2025 at around 2:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Dagat-Dagatan Avenue, Brgy. 28, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 5:40 AM.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in the National Capital Region (NCR), actively participated in the response operation and maintained continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of Caloocan City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.
