

# **DSWD DROMIC Report #23 on the Effects of Shear Line**

as of 06 March 2025. 6PM

### I. Situation Overview


Issued on 08 January 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by Shear Line that may have caused possible flash floods or landslides in Visayas, Bicol Region, Quezon, Marinduque, Romblon, and Dinagat Islands.

On the same day, various areas in the provinces of Albay, Sorsogon, Camarines Sur, and Catanduanes experienced intense heavy rainfall and widespread flooding. Moreover, due to continuous heavy rainfall caused by the Shear Line, several flooding and landslide incidents were reported in low-lying barangays in Cadiz City, Negros Occidental including parts of Eastern Samar and Northern Samar.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **259,756 families** or **1,079,164 persons** are affected in **1,115 barangays** in **Regions V**, **VI**, and **VIII** (see Annex A).



# III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center
 A total of 9,799 families or 45,106 persons sought temporary shelter in 158 evacuation centers in Regions V, VI, and VIII (see Annex B).



#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **6,607 families** or **25,235 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **16,406 families** or **70,341 persons** were displaced in **Regions V, VI**, and **VIII** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Region V** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱113,886,460.05 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which ₱113,556,960.05 from DSWD and ₱329,500.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).
