

# **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the** Fire Incident in Brgy. 28, Caloocan City

as of 22 February 2025, 6AM

#### I. **Situation Overview**

On 12 February 2025 at around 2:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Dagat-Dagatan Avenue, Brgy. 28, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 5:40 AM.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in the National Capital Region (NCR), provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of 170 families or 680 persons are affected in Brgy. 28, Caloocan City (see Annex A).
