

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte as of 20 February 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2025 at around 7:38 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 39, Calvary Hill, Tacloban City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 9:04 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **169 families** or **605 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **18 families** or **90 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Abucay Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **151 families** or **515 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **169 families** or **605 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **111 houses** were damaged; of which, **102** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 39, Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,130,339.04** worth of assistance was provided by the **Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
