

# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City

as of 20 February 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2025 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 7 Relocation Site, Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **29 families** or **95 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **73 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Buntatala Covered Court** in **Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **22 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives(see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **29 families** or **95 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Buntatala**, **Jaro**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}391,594.80\$ worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}299,280.00\$ from **DSWD** and \$\mathbb{P}92,314.80\$ from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
