

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City

as of 04 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2025 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 7 Relocation Site, Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **29 families** or **95 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **73 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Buntatala Covered Court** in **Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **22 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives(see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **29 families** or **95 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}307,644.80\$ worth of assistance was provided by \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}215,330.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}92,314.80\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
